



Kangaroo Ground Pony Club Membership Prices

The KGPC committee review our membership rates annually for the upcoming season.

To keep our fees as low as possible we rely on members and their families to volunteer for roles and support our rallies, events and working bees.

This year Pony Club Victoria (PCV) has introduced a new Ready2Ride program which is aimed at engaging new riders with age-appropriate activities. The Ready2Ride 'rookies' will have an opportunity to participate in a program specifically designed by PCV, which includes two sessions per rally and eligibility to work towards certificates. This program has a reduced PCV insurance levy and will be available to members who may not be competing throughout the year.

As per advice from Pony Club Victoria there will also be a minor increase in the PCV levy, which has been included in the new membership fees:

The KGPC membership rates for the 2022 season are as follows:

Membership Fees: \$430 for junior members and **\$445** for senior members

Ready to Ride: \$354 for beginner riders under the age of 10.


A pro rata fee will apply for all club members admitted between the 1st of July and the 31st December inclusive.

The membership fee includes a 24/7 Personal Accident Insurance Cover. This insurance enables KGPC riders to claim for injuries sustained whilst engaging in equestrian pursuits at any time of the day. This means riders are covered for Personal Accident outside of Pony Club endorsed activities.

Payment of membership prior to 1st January is a necessary requirement for your insurance, attendance at rallies and access to the KGPC grounds. As per the club policy, should any members anticipate difficulty paying their membership they can email the KGPC Treasurer to discuss a payment plan.

Also all parents will need to renew their Supporter Membership. This is a requirement for anyone visiting our grounds on more than two occasions throughout the season as per the PCAV guidelines and the Victorian Child Safety Standards.

Each family is required to complete rostered rally duty in the canteen and on the grounds, as well as attending the yearly working bee. We are a volunteer organisation and while we understand that families are very busy, participation is essential for our club to operate.
